AMENDS LAWS RELATED TO INITIATIVE, REFERENDUM, RECALL PETITION PROCESSES, INCLUDING CIRCULATION, SIGNATURE GATHERING, SIGNATURE VERIFICATION

RESULT OF “YES” VOTE: “Yes” vote amends laws related to initiative, referendum, and recall petition processes, including processes for filing petitions, circulating petitions, gathering petition signatures, and verifying signatures.

RESULT OF “NO” VOTE: “No” vote retains current laws related to initiative, referendum, and recall petition processes, including processes for filing petitions, circulating petitions, gathering petition signatures, verifying signatures.

SUMMARY: Currently, petitioner for initiative, referendum petition must file 25 sponsorship signatures (increases to 1,000 in 2008); upon verification, must obtain certain number of petition signatures to place measure on ballot. Electors currently entitled to vote may sign petition. Petition circulator’s failure to correctly certify signature sheet, comply with other legal requirements, invalidates sheet. Chief petitioner is liable for circulator’s acts. Beginning in 2008, paid circulators must register, be trained by state. Proposed measure requires 25 sponsorship signatures. Presumes signature valid if person registered to vote within 10 days, prohibits invalidation based solely on circulator’s act. Requires incarceration for forging 20 signatures. Prohibits rules increasing circulating costs, invalidating otherwise valid signatures, requiring paid circulators to register. Repeals making chief petitioner liable for circulator’s acts. Other provisions.

Instructions for Signers

- Only active registered voters of the state of Oregon may sign a petition. Sign your full name, as you did when you registered to vote.
- Please fill in the date on which you signed the petition, your printed name and your residence address in the spaces provided.
- Initial any changes that you or the circulator makes to your printed name, residence address or date on which you signed the petition.
- It is advisable to use a pen for signing petitions.
- It is unlawful to sign any person's name other than your own. Do not sign another person's name under any circumstances.
- It is unlawful to sign a petition more than once.
- It is unlawful for a person to knowingly sign a petition when the person is not qualified to sign it.
